Responsibilities:

- Vacuum, Shampoo and Detail Interior of buses (including dashboards and consoles)
- Wash and Detail Exterior of buses
- Clean door trim, hinges and windows
- Empty garbage, sweep and mop floors
- Maintain fluid levels and handle various chemicals
- Maintaining Wash Bay equipment and water softening equipment
- Ensure safe work practices are being followed
- Follow procedures and complete required paperwork
